What is Growing Up GREAT?




Growing Up GREAT! is a gendertransformative sexual and reproductive health program for very young adolescents (10-14 years) in Kinshasa, DRC.

Piloted from September 2017-May 2018 in two poor communes of Kinshasa and scaled up into additional sites since 2019.




